



The Basic Food Program (or SNAP) is a federal program that helps people with low income buy food at the grocery store. It is administered locally by the Washington State Department of Social & Health Services.

### Do I Qualify?

You may be eligible to receive Basic Food if you live in Washington State *and*

- You're a U.S. citizen or legally present in the U.S.
- Make less than the amount show to the right

Other rules apply so be sure and visit or call us today to verify eligibility and see if Basic Food can help you and your family.

EBT benefits are accepted at most grocery stores. You use it just like a debit card. Your benefits are renewed on the same date each month.
