## Application for the Community Action and Skagit Valley Food Co-op Farm to Food Bank

### **Application Deadline: Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup>**

Thank you for applying to the Community Action Farm to Food Bank Program!

This program is designed to support both farmers and food pantries in our community. With support from the Skagit Valley Food Co-op's "Growing Good Fund", Community Action will administer loans to farmers who will pay back those loans in donated food products. Donations will be made to the Community Action Skagit Food Distribution Center in Sedro Woolley, who will distribute them to hunger relief organizations in Skagit County. This initiative strengthens the regional food system by cultivating long-term, mutually beneficial relationships between farms and the emergency food network, increasing both economic stability for producers and food security for families.

Loans will be administered in spring of 2026 and must be repaid in donated produce by December 31, 2031 (5 year term). Donations can happen at any time during the 5 year pay back period. Farmers will be expected to deliver product in new and appropriate packaging along with documentation so the donation can be properly tracked. Documentation will include the date, name of the farm, product, case size/poundage, and price. Used packaging is okay for fruits and vegetables as long as it is in good condition (clean and free of tears/rips that jeopardize the strength of the box). The maximum award amount for 2026 is \$10,000. The donated value of goods will be established at the time of award and will be re-evaluated each year based on wholesale market prices.

Before applying, please read the eligibility criteria below:

- Have at least 2 years of farming experience (2024 or prior)
- Located in Skagit County
- Be able to pay back the loan in donated food products within 5 years
- Priority will be given to farms who need support with equipment and small infrastructure projects to grow and expand their business
- We are looking for a diverse selection of food products through this program. Priority will be given to farms who can provide food products that are needed for the Skagit Food Pantries and provide a clear plan for how their loan will be paid back. Examples include:
  - Produce: Fruit/Vegetables
    - ♣ Produce items we are not prioritizing:
      - Potatoes, onions, squash, and herbs
  - Meat
  - Eggs
  - Dairy

- Be willing to report back at the end of the year on how these funds impacted your farm operation
- Willing to work with hunger relief organizations
- Donations for loan paybacks will be treated as wholesale and priced accordingly. Priority will be given to farms who have experience with, or are interested in expanding to wholesale markets
